

Graduate Fellowships, 2026-2027

CSGGE Graduate Fellowships and Award

The Center for the Study of Global Gender Equity (CSGGE) holds an annual competition for graduate student awards with a deadline mid-February. We offer two full fellowships through the Rita and Arnold Goodman Fellowship and the Barbara A. Yates International Fellowship. We also have smaller research award through the Accad & Vieille International Research award. Please note that you must be a graduate student in the Gender Relations in International Development (GRID) minor to apply for the Barbara A. Yates Fellowship. The Evelyn Accad and Paul Vieille International Award require research to be on issues related to women in North Africa, Iran, or the Middle East.

A graduate student enrolled at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign may apply for one or more of the awards on the application form by submitting the required materials. Only one application form needed. **Both the application and reference letter submission deadline is Monday, February 16, 2026, 11:59pm.**

AY 2026-2027 Illinois Global Institute Language Fellowship

The Illinois Global Institute Graduate Language Fellowship is now open. The fellowship provides support for critical language training necessary to fields of academic and professional development for UIUC students. The fellowship offers academic year support (AY 2026-2027) to graduate students at the MA or PhD level. IGI Graduate Language Fellows will receive a \$22,000 stipend.

The applications are due Friday, January 30, 2026, at 11:59pm CT. Letters of Recommendation are due Friday, February 6, 2026, at 11:59pm CT. Award/Alternate/Rejection Letters will be sent throughout the Spring 2026 Semester.
